# Pirate tic tac toe



## **Instructions**

#### You will need:

- 1 each 24 cm squares of red, grey, black and white felt
- 15cm length of ribbon or binding
- 2cm length of sew on Velcro or a snap fastener
- Optional 27cm square backing fabric and iron on interfacing

## **Cutting out**

Using grey felt, cut four strips about 1cm wide and 21cm long.

Cut out the templates (see below) for the skull and crossbones, trace onto the white felt, you'll need five of each design. Then cut out carefully.

### The sewing bit

Optional - to add a backing fabric - iron the interfacing to the wrong side of the fabric. Then fold each edge in by 1.3cm and press and pin. Put to one side for later.

Pin your grey strips into a tic tac toe pattern (check the that skulls and crossbones fit in the squares before you sew). The middle square should be about 7cm x 7cm.

Sew around the edges of the grey felt, until it is all sewn down.

Pin your backing fabric, right side out, to the back of your felt and sew all around the outside.

Cut a rectangle of black felt 24cm x 11cm. Sew one side of the Velcro to one end of the rectangle.

Fold to form a pocket with a flap, with your Velcro on the outside of the pocket. Sew down the right side. Then place one end of the ribbon/binding between felt on the left side. Sew the left side, making sure that the ribbon is sewn in.

Sew the other end of the ribbon to the right side of your tic tac toe board.

Sew the other side of the Velcro to the inside of the flap - so it matches up when shut.
